New Hope for Women (NHFW) supports people in Sagadahoc, Lincoln, Knox, and Waldo Counties affected by domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. NHFW also offers prevention services to create a safer and healthier future for our communities.

In fiscal year 2020, NHFW staff answered 3,263 calls and spent 1,530 hours providing counseling, resources, and support to callers. During the pandemic, NHFW has responded by increasing support through email, texts and chat functions providing 1,071 contacts to people seeking support. NHFW has also provided 3,056 emergency shelter nights: an astounding increase from 203 in the last fiscal year.
